Certificate II in Spatial Information Services - Online (CPP20107)

This course is delivered online and provides a unique introduction to spatial information services. The course teaches students how to collect spatial data using GPS and aerial imagery and to produce maps. Students also gain complementary skills in information technology applications and processes.

The Certificate II in Spatial Information Services (CPP20107) provides pathway opportunities to the Diploma of Surveying (CPP50107) or the Diploma of Spatial Information Services (CPP50207) or related courses.

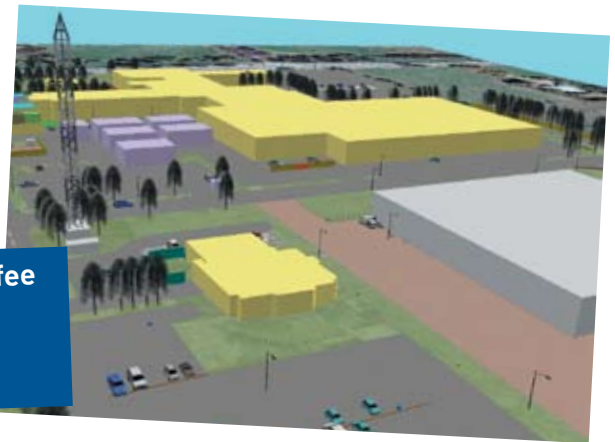
